

HOW TO CREATE A PRINT-READY FILE - ROLL-UP XXL ROLLER BANNERS

The following instructions will help you create a print-ready file. If after reading them you are still unsure about anything, please visit the FAQ section of our website, request a professional File Check or contact customer services.

1 FILE FORMAT

Send your file in PDF format in 1:1 scale (not password protected).

2 COLOUR

All files should be sent in **CMYK** (cyan, magenta, yellow, black), with the **Fogra 39 colour profile**. Images in RGB or with PANTONE colours will be converted automatically using a standard colour separation profile.

3 RESOLUTION

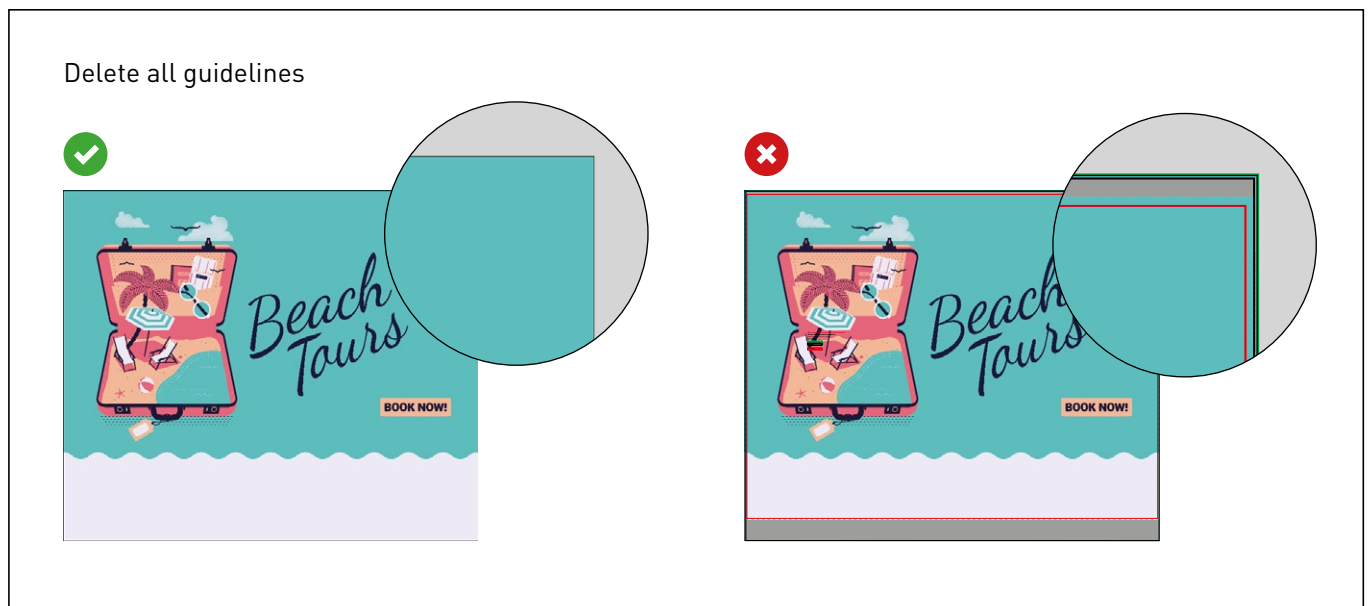
The optimal resolution for the print files is **between 100 and 150 dpi**.

4 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The minimum printable line weight is 0.5 pt.

5 TEMPLATE

Always download the template for the product you purchased from the website and use it as the basis for positioning your artwork: this will make it easier to create a print-ready file. **Insert your artwork on the 'Artwork' layer, delete all the guidelines** and save the file as a PDF. Do not alter the scale of the design or **resize the template**.

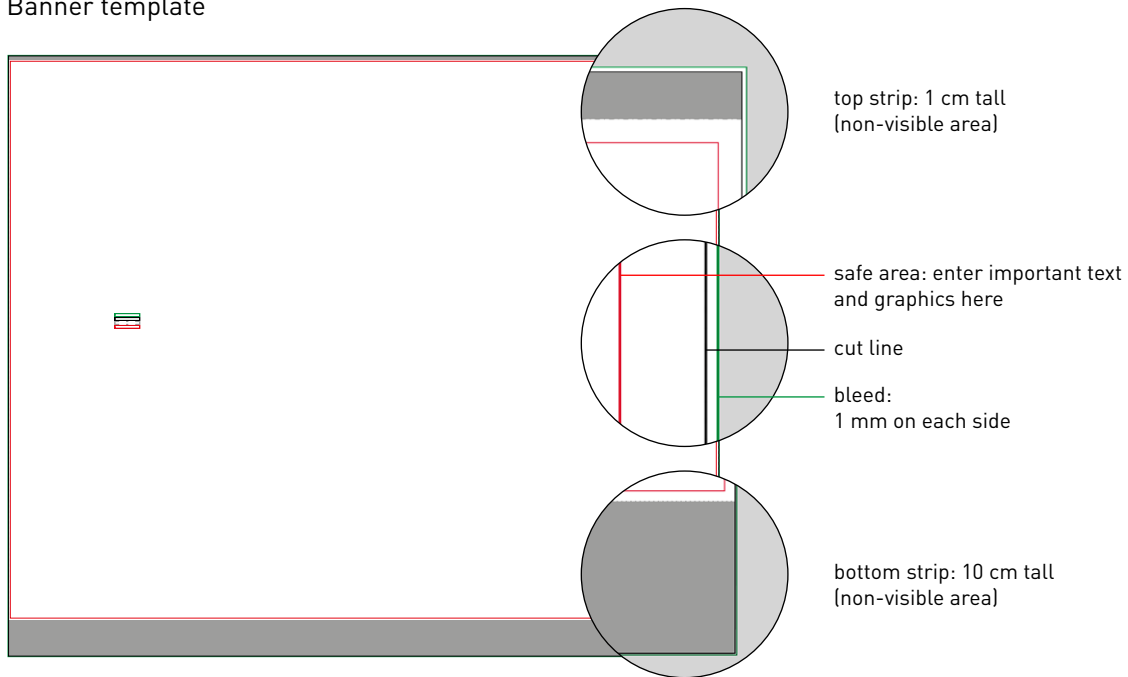


6 BLEED AND NON-VISIBLE AREAS

You will find **the bleed of 1 mm on each side** already set up on the template. Insert any important text or graphics in the safe area (red line).

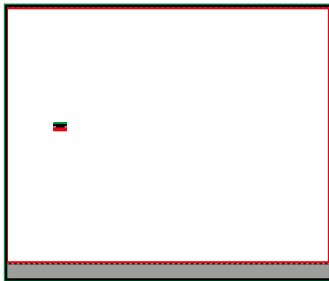
Do not place important elements in the grey strip at the bottom (10 cm) or top (1 cm) of the template: these areas will not be visible on the finished item, as they will be rolled up inside the frame of the banner.

Template dimensions: 200.2x211.2 cm

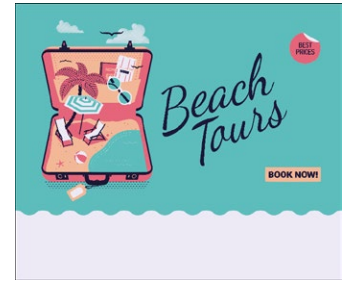
